The IAQVEC Conference Series, first held in Montreal in 1992, has since been organized in various regions around the world. The most recent conference was held in Tokyo in 2023, and the next conference is scheduled to take place in Los Angeles in 2026. The IAQVEC conferences cover a broad range of key research areas with the objective of simultaneously improving Indoor Environmental Quality (IEQ) and energy efficiency, while enhancing wellbeing and sustainability.

Proposal Requirements

The proposal should include the following information:

- Proposed conference dates
- Proposed host city and venue
- Key milestones and schedule
- Main members of the organizing committee (including the Conference Chair)
- Proposed conference theme and topics
- Expected number of participants
- Estimated financial plan (income and expenditure)

Selection Process

Shortlisted candidates will be invited to an interview at the IAQVEC Association Board of Directors (BOD) Meeting, scheduled to be held in late February 2026.
