## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

IAQVEC 2023, the 11th international conference on indoor air quality, ventilation & energy conservation in buildings, will be held in Tokyo, Japan next May. This is the second time in Japan since Sendai conference in 2007. Welcome back to Japan!



The theme of the conference is "For Future Sustainable Society". Although countermeasures for climate change are among the urgent issues ahead of us; a sustainable society cannot be realized only by climate measures. It is to build a society where human beings can live safely in the future. However, in the world, there are still conflicts to struggle for resources and territory. It is a tragedy. In 1990, the Jacques Cartier Centre selected the Indoor Air, Ventilation and Energy Conservation Building (IAQVECs) as one subject of its 1992 conference program to encourage a gathering international experts, government official, engineers and architects from around the world to share their knowledge on these important subjects. This "integrate/holistic Approach" provides a framework optimizing good indoor environment without increasing energy consumption deteriorating the environment.



During the current long-lasting COVID-19 pandemic, integrating various IAQ strategies mitigate the risk of virus infection in an energy-efficient and cost-effective manner crucial to human health and wellbeing as well as developing low-carbon and sustainable buildings and communities. The next meeting which will be the 30th anniversary of IAQVEC will take place in Japan.



The 2023 meeting will be held in Tokyo, Japan and is chaired by Ryozo Ooka, Professor at The University of Tokyo, and Prof. Shin-ichi Tanabe, Professor at Waseda University. The scientific committee is composed of the over 150 prominent and active researchers. Over 500 abstracts have been submitted at the present. The theme of the conference is "For Future Sustainability." This will become the model conference after COVID-19.




## THE 11TH INTERNATIONAL IAQVEC CONFERENCE 20-23 MAY, 2023, TOKYO, JAPAN



## **IAQVEC 2023**

The 11th international conference on indoor air quality, ventilation & energy conservation in buildings (IAQVEC 2023), will be held on 20-23 May, 2023 in Tokyo organized by IAQVEC steering committee and sponsored by Institute of Industrial Science, The University of Tokyo and many domestic and international association (SHASE, AIJ, ASHRAE, REHVA, IABP, IBPSA, ISIAQ etc.). As of the end of August, there were 520 abstract submissions. The conference paper can be indexed and recorded on SCOPUS if the author selects. The good papers will be invited to the special issues of the sponsor journals such as Sustainable Cities and Society, Building and Environment, Energy and Building, and Energy and Built Environment and so on. Also, the committee is preparing various awards for good papers and presentations. The conference venue will be changed from Institute of Industrial Science, The University of Tokyo to Tokyo Big Sight due to increase of the expected participants.


